- 2. Common Swallowing Disorders
- 3. Signs and Symptoms of Swallowing Disorders
- 4. Risk Management/Safe Swallowing Techniques
- 5. Dietary Modifications
- 6. Ongoing Management Issues

Program: Total Duration of Introductory Presentation is 60 minutes. Programming can accommodate the needs of your particular work environment – for example, it will be possible to offer an intensive "Swallowing Awareness Week" with three sessions over the week to maximise opportunities for all staff to attend. Other facilities have varied the day/time when offering a series of weekly sessions. Additional modules (Dysphagia Therapy/Additional Investigations/Disability) are available on request.

Cost: \$250 per workshop, including handouts. We will liaise with you regarding your audiovisual facilities. Recommended group size >10 attendees to provide training at \$25 per participant.
